1. Digital DMR standard repeater		
1	The DR3000 has been discontinued – will it's update, the SLR5500, be acceptable to the project?	Yes, it must be updated.
2	Our supplier has asked for more information on the current communications system you are running, especially with relation to: - Voice and data recording – do you have a recording system in place? Equipment offered is almost certain to be compatible but does not carry voice recording function itself.	At this stage, we don't consider voice recording feature for the system.
2. Portable DMR standard radio		
3	You have 36 portable radios but then 116 antennas, which is an odd amount for that number of radios (3.222 antennas each) – please clarify no. of antennas needed	It's needed, please follow technical specifications.
4	Are the 36 batteries requested in the specifications spare batteries? As the radios come with a standard battery themselves – again please clarify	It's needed, please follow technical specifications.
3. Mobile DMR standard digital radio		
5	The line cord in this item is not required for a standard vehicle mounted mobile – should these be omitted or do you want them regardless?	It's needed, please follow technical specifications.
6	The frequency splits for the antennas on both portables and mobiles do not directly match those for the antennas which are available for the Motorola kit. This is not a substantive issue as the pricing for antennas is the same and there is an antenna to cover each of the requirements but we just wanted to notify the project	We know it doesn't match exactly. We need Antennas operating in required frequency ranges.
